CONJUNCTIVITIS

(Pink Eye)

Dear Parent:

Your child may have been exposed to conjunctivitis.

Please check your child's eyes daily to look for:

- Redness
- Itching
- Pain
- Discharge
- Eye lid swelling which may be stuck together upon awakening

If your child has <u>any</u> of the above symptoms, please consult your child's physician as conjunctivitis is **HIGHLY contagious**.

Should your child have conjunctivitis, they <u>must</u> be on the antibiotic eye drops for 24 - 48 hours before they are no longer contagious. Only <u>then</u> can they return to school.

Suggestions to avoid transmission to others:

- ♦ Avoid touching or rubbing eyes
- ♦ Wash hands frequently throughout day with soap and water
- ♦ Use a separate hand towel at home for cleaning your hands and face
- ♦ Anytime you touch your eyes you <u>must</u> wash your hands <u>immediately</u>

Please notify the School Nurse if your child is diagnosed with Conjunctivitis.

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
