COXSACKIE VIRUS (Hand, Foot & Mouth Disease)

Dear Parent:
Your child may have been exposed to Coxsackie virus (Hand, Foot & Mouth Disease) through contact.
Coxsackie virus is one of the contagious Childhood illnesses. The symptoms of fever, poor appetite, runny nose and sore throat can appear 3-5 days after exposure. A blister-like rash on the hands, feet & in the mouth usually develops 1-2 days after the initial symptoms.
A child is considered contagious when the first symptoms appear and may continue until the blister-like rash disappears.
Consult with your child's physician if your child shows any of the above symptoms.
Please notify the School Nurse if your child is diagnosed with Coxsackie virus.
