Dear NSHA Families and Faculty,

As New York State continues to release guidelines for school reopening, we are developing NSHA's plan and are committed to complying with mandates from the state and the Department of Health. Our full re-opening plan will be shared in early August.

As you read what follows below and communications that will be sent over the next few weeks, please note that a safe and successful re-opening of our campuses is dependent on **full cooperation from our parent body;** we expect our parents to partner with us in our efforts as we navigate through our reopening and the 2020-2021 academic year.

Travel Advisory and Mandatory Quarantine

New York has issued a mandatory quarantine following visits to certain states with significant community spread of Covid-19. <u>Click here</u> to view the list of states that meet the criteria for required quarantine. Please continue to check this list for updates as it can change.

If you have traveled internationally or from within one of the states that are subject to the travel advisory, you must quarantine when you enter New York for 14 days from the last travel within such designated state, provided that on the date you returned to New York such state was subject to the travel advisory requiring quarantine.

In light of the above, no student who has traveled internationally or from within one of the designated states that are subject to the travel advisory will be permitted to enter school during the required quarantine period. Please ensure you keep this policy in mind as you make travel arrangements for your family during the last few weeks of summer as well as throughout the school year while the quarantine orders remain in effect. School start dates vary across divisions- please ensure you are aware of the date on which each of your children start school and plan accordingly.

Parents who have a child that is subject to quarantine, due to travel or for any other reason, as of the first day of school **must** contact a member of the Administration. Failure to do so places all our students and faculty at risk and may result in your child not being permitted to continue at NSHA.

Parents or family members of students who have traveled internationally or to states on the advisory list for business or personal activities should contact the Administration for guidance.

Flu Vaccine Requirement for all Students and Faculty

Please note that based on recommendations from our medical consultant, NSHA will be requiring all faculty and students in grades Toddler-Twelve to receive the Flu vaccine this year and to submit submit a record of inoculation to the school no later than November 30, 2020.
