



NSHAHS Immunization Compliance Agreement

In order to protect the health and safety of all students and faculty, North Shore Hebrew Academy High School ("NSHAHS") is committed to compliance with New York Public Health Law § 2164. Public Health Law § 2164 generally requires students to receive and remain current with age-appropriate immunizations and/or boosters for poliomyelitis, mumps, measles, diphtheria, Haemophilus influenza type b (Hib), rubella, varicella, pertussis, tetanus, pneumococcal disease, meningococcal disease, and hepatitis B, and generally prohibits students from attending school without submitting appropriate documentation relation to these immunizations. All parents of students at NSHAHS are therefore expected to comply with the requirements of Public Health Law § 2164, and compliance with the law is a requirement to enroll and/or remain enrolled at NSHAHS.
